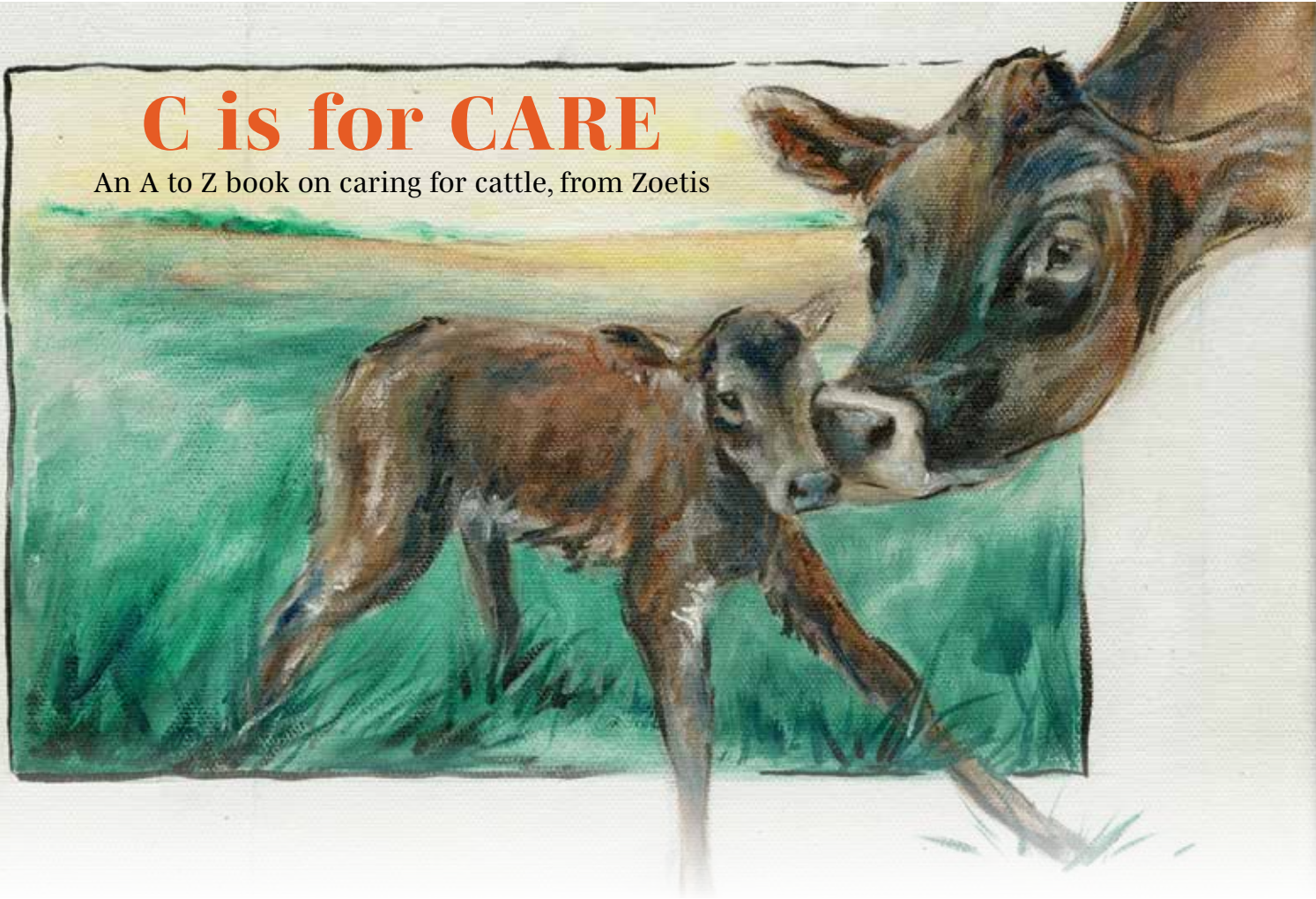


# C is for CARE

## Let's Create a Cow Craft!

A note to parents and teachers: You can bring “C is for Care” to life with a hands-on craft that is simple and easy to do with your little ones! This cow headband is a fun way to create an opportunity for open-ended play to reinforce lessons learned in the story!

**Supplies:**

**Construction Paper**  
(2 white, 2 black and 1 pink)

**Glue**  
**Scissors**  
**Stapler**



### Step 1

Fold one black paper in half lengthwise and cut along the fold.



### Step 2

Lay the two strips of paper short end to short end and staple them together.



### Step 3

Invite the child to cut irregular circles and ovals out of white paper for the spots. Then glue the white spots onto the long black strip and allow them to dry.



### Step 4

For the ears, cut two rounded triangles out of the other black paper.



### Step 5

Cut two smaller rounded triangles out of the pink paper and then glue the pink triangles on top of the black triangles.



### Step 6

Staple the long black strips you cut at the beginning into a circle headband that fits around the child's head.



### Step 7

When the glue on the ears has dried, gently fold 1/3 of the ear over lengthwise and put a staple at the bottom to create the folded appearance of a real cow ear.



### Step 8

Staple the ears, angled down, to each side of the headband.



### Step 9

MOO! You're ready to have fun, little one!
